

BRIDGE PAINTER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: The work primarily involves sandblasting and painting highway bridges. Duties are performed under the direct supervision of the Senior Bridge Painter. When weather conditions do not permit bridge painting, an incumbent may be assigned a variety of manual tasks associated with Public Works operations. A Bridge Painter does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- Loads and unloads supplies and equipment;
- Sets up and dismantles scaffolding;
- Mixes paint and fills paint sprayer;
- Charges sandblaster with silica;
- Sandblasts rust, scale, and flaking paint from bridge;
- Services and cleans compressor and truck;
- Drives truck carrying supplies and personnel;
- Performs a variety of manual tasks.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES, AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS: Working knowledge of the tools, materials, and equipment used to paint bridgework; ability to sandblast and spray paint structural steel safely and efficiently; ability to follow oral and written directions; ability to drive a truck; manual dexterity; mechanical aptitude; ability to tolerate the odors and dirt associated with spray painting; physical condition equal to the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Possession of a Class B Commercial Operator's license at time of appointment.
