

SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is a responsible part-time position calling for the exercise of considerable vigilance in directing traffic for the protection of children going to and from school. Work is performed independently with only occasional direction from a superior. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- Assists children crossing street;
- Instructs children concerning proper places for crossing street and precautions that are to be observed;
- Directs traffic at school crossings.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES, AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS: Ability to deal with the public using firmness and tact; ability to get along well with children; familiarity with first-aid methods; good powers of observation; physical condition sufficient to perform the essential functions of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: None.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT FOR APPOINTMENT IN SCHOOL DISTRICTS / BOCES:

Per regulations of the Commissioner of Education, to be employed in a position designated by a school district or BOCES as involving direct contact with students, a clearance for employment from the State Education Department is required.
