

SIGN PAINTER

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES: Performs a variety of semi-skilled painting tasks; does related work as required.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is routine work involving responsibility for the efficient performance of semi-skilled sign and miscellaneous painting. The work is performed under the general supervision of the Automotive Mechanic Foreman.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative only)

- Prepares surfaces for painting by washing, scraping, and sanding;
- Repairs, letters, and erects standard highway signs;
- Paints highway markers such as railroad warnings and lanes;
- Applies red lead to steel to prevent rusting;
- Erects and paints guard rails;
- Cleans and paints bridges and highway department structures;
- Sets out traffic counters and keeps records or readings;
- When not engaged in painting, assists in a variety of maintenance tasks.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES: Working knowledge of the practices, tools, terminology, and accident precautions of the trade; ability to follow simple oral and written instructions; ability to operate power painting equipment; ability to rig and work from scaffolds; good color perception; good motor, hand and eye coordination; manual dexterity; good physical condition.

ACCEPTABLE EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING: One year of experience as a painter and graduation from a standard grade school; or any equivalent combination of experience and training sufficient to indicate ability to do the work.
